


Rocky Mountain Paleozoic Oil Study

Analysis of a suite of Paleozoic-sourced Oils from Rocky Mountain Basins



GeoMark has completed a regional assessment of Paleozoic-sourced oils in select Rocky Mountain basins. The purpose of this study is to detect and characterize Paleozoic petroleum systems that may have been overlooked by past exploration efforts. Paleozoic source units have received limited attention because of their depth, and where they exist may represent economically attractive resource opportunities.

In its entirety, the study involves the detailed analysis of 225 Paleozoic sourced oil samples. Analytical data for the study are provided digitally for a separate subscription fee. Maps and plots used to interpret the data are provided in an interpretive commentary given as an Adobe PDF file.
